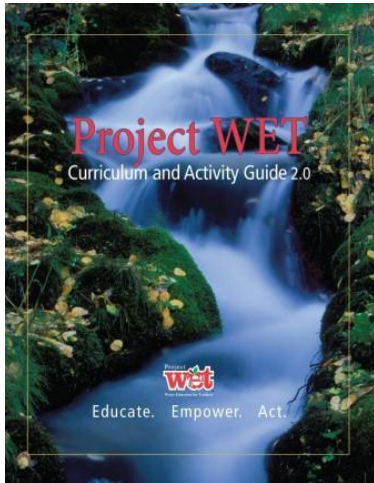




2012 Water Education – Generation 2.0
