Agent – appointed by the Bureau of Indian affairs to supervise US Government programs on a reservation or in a region.

Bureau of Indian Affairs – Government agency with the department of the Interior originally to manage trade and other Indian relations. Now, the BIA tries to make programs that help Native Americans to manage their own affairs and improve educational opportunities, as well as their social and economic well being.

Indian Claims Commission – Government created by congress in 1946 to hear and rule on claims (like unfulfilled treaty terms) by Native Americans against the US.

Indian Reorganization Act – In 1934 federal law ended individual land ownership and went back to reservation communities. It also created an autonomous tribal government.
