

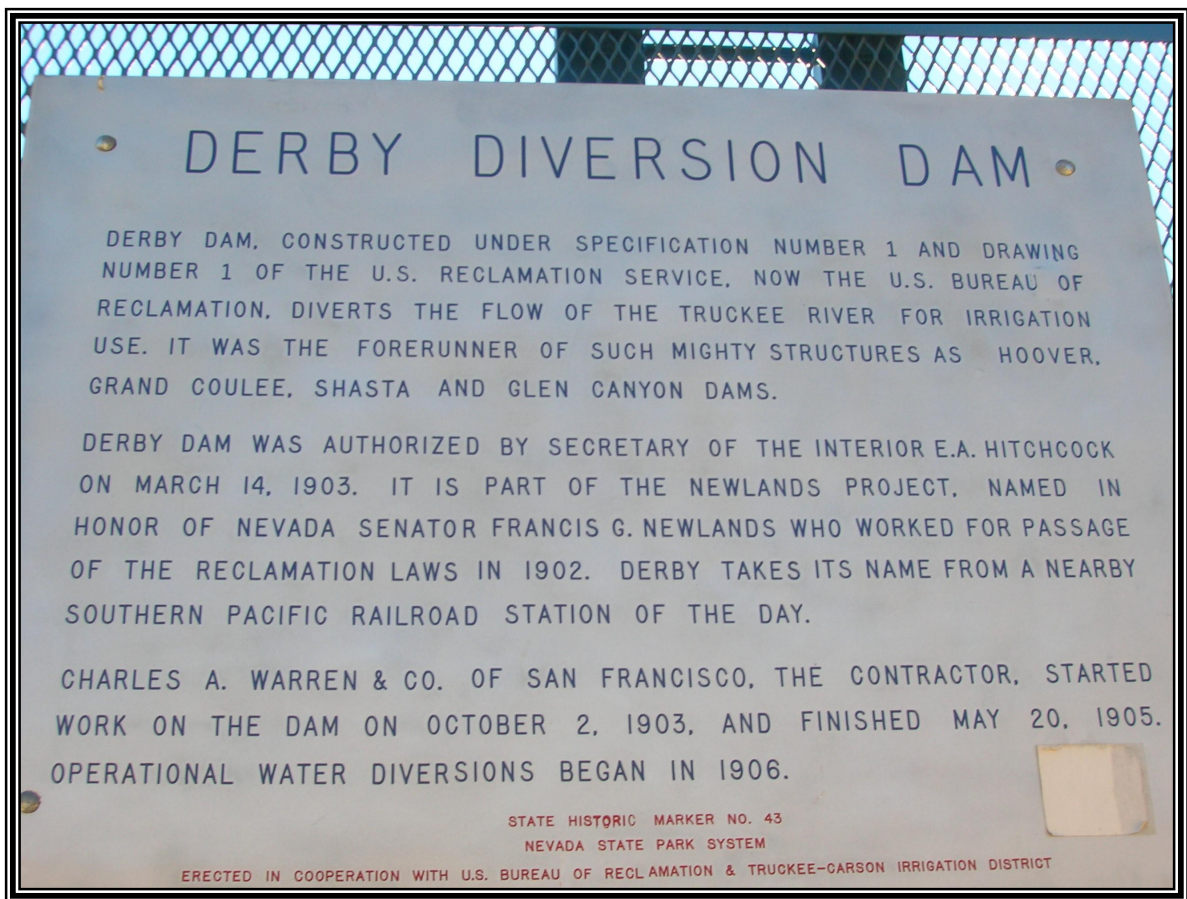

The Derby Dam was built in an attempt to claim some of the Great Basin Desert and turn it into farming land. Only 30 years after its completion in 1905 Winnemucca Lake dried up completely and Pyramid Lake receded approximately 90 feet. Today there are still water disputes over the diversion of water from the Truckee River.



The Derby Dam can be reached from Highway 80: exit 36. This sign is posted on the side of the road attached to a blue metal post in the shape of Nevada.
