The Nevada State Museum was built in 1866. Inside its walls you'll experience a life-sized ghost town, walk through a silver mine and see the actual equipment used to stamp over 50 million dollars in gold and silver coins mined from the Comstock Lode.

Make sure to visit the Under One Sky Exhibit that has displays on the tribes of the Northern Great Basin. Also check out the display of hand-woven baskets by Washoe artist Dat So La Lee who is considered to be the best Native American Basket Maker.
