

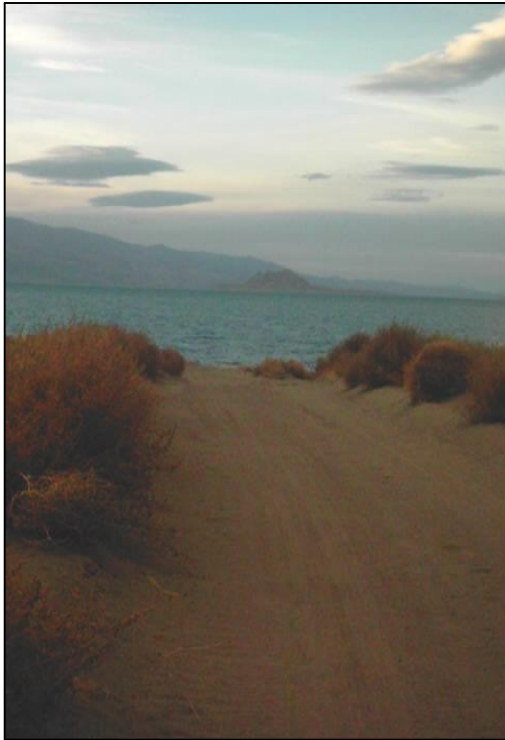


KOYOOE TUKADU:

“As the largest fragment of the parent Lake Lahontan, Pyramid Lake is approximately thirty miles long and from five to ten miles wide. The lake has no outlet and but one inlet at its south end where the mouth of the Truckee River empties.” (Herman pg3)



To get to Pyramid Lake take Highway 80 to West Fernley. This exit brings you to highway 447 north. Turn left at highway 446 to stop at the Culture Center for permits and more information about the lake. The Culture Center is the well designed brown building (before the Junior/Senior High School) located on the right.
