- There are examples of almost all 5 areas for the four groups of people: ancient people, Paiute, emigrants and modern.
- It is recommended you do this activity after reading the histories of the area.
- The items can be placed upon the picture board to help students visualize what the area looked like and the essentials that were used at that time.
