Direct Results

- Inventoried two historic homesteads, Bernard's and Van Riper Place
- Recorded historic can dump with GPS Coordinates
- 2 campsites were re-inventoried, cleaned, and fire rings reduced at High Rock Creek

- 1 campsite cleaned and dispersed near Steven's Camp Meadow
- Cleaned and disinfected Steven's Camp
- Removed 150 lbs of debris and 3 mine posts

SUMMARY: During a scouting trip for a Leave No Trace Trainer Course NOS inventoried two historic homestead and were able to remove 150 lbs of trash and 3 mine posts from the wilderness. NOS is also assisting the BLM with campsite monitoring to GPS locations of impact and encourage active stewardship.
