SUMMARY:

The Nevada Outdoor School teamed up with Friends of Nevada Wilderness and Friends of Black Rock High Rock for this event. 26 volunteers Rehabilitated 2.25 miles of road which had been impacted by vehicle use, created two gabions to protect the Desert Dace from a non-native, aggressive fish species, transplanted 8 endangered Basalt Cinquefoil and improved 2.25 miles of trail surrounding the Soldier Meadows Hot Springs.
